## Goodwill's Mission

Goodwill Industries of Dallas exists to provide job training and employment to persons with disabilities and disadvantages to help them transform their lives through the power of jobs.

## Goodwill's History

Beginning in 1902, Methodist minister Edgar J. Helms began collecting unwanted clothing and household goods from the wealthier neighborhoods of Boston. He did this so that unemployed settlers living in the poor South End could earn wages, develop skills and acquire practical work experience by restoring items for resale. Funds generated from the sale of the second-hand merchandise were used to pay wages to the workers, laying the foundation for Goodwill Industries.

The Dallas Goodwill began in 1923 when several women hosted a clothing drive and rummage sale at the Southern Methodist Church in a 100-sq. ft. settlement house serving 50 people. Goodwill Industries of Dallas has since grown into a dynamic force for change in the community—serving more than 70,000 people.

The meeting rooms at Goodwill Industries of Dallas headquarters provide an attractive, well-maintained and inexpensive place to conduct various types of business meetings—including committee or staff meetings, planning sessions, training programs, luncheons and receptions.

Goodwill's meeting rooms are available for rent to all businesses, including for-profit companies, not-for-profit groups and governmental organizations.

Our 270,000 sq. ft., state-of-the-art facility is centrally located in West Dallas with easy access to I-35, I-30, Highway 114 and 183.

Our meeting space can accommodate groups ranging in size from 10 to 300 (note: 250 seating capacity).

Additional services available include high-tech audio/video equipment, podium and wireless or wired microphones.

# Facts About Our Meeting Space

Conference rooms can be configured to fit your needs. The conference rooms open to a large mezzanine area, ideal for mingling and attendee breaks.

Goodwill's four meeting rooms can accommodate different capacities—from smaller rooms for more intimate conference meetings of up to 30 people, to spacious rooms for large events. The largest single room can accommodate up to 125 people. Partitions can be removed to utilize combinations of rooms to meet your space requirements. Combined, the space can accommodate up to 300 people.

Rooms are available to rent Monday-Friday from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.
